Thank you for your interest in becoming an ambassador for Michigan State University. Over 10,000 people visit MSU's campus and look to our tour guides to present the University and what it has to offer.

Campus Tours has been remodeled from previous years, and this year, we are introducing an application process for anyone interested in serving the University as a guide. We are looking for dedicated Spartans with a passion for MSU and willingness to share that with those who visit our campus. The forty applicants that best exemplify these and other Spartan values will be invited to become the face of MSU for visitors.

Applying and becoming a member of Campus Tours will not be simply filling out forms, but each applicant will be required to submit a completed application, including well-thought answers to the questions asked. After the applications are reviewed by the Co-Directors, those who qualify will be asked to participate in a group interview as the next step in the application process. The Co-Directors will then select a group of forty people to represent Campus Tours for the 2007-08 academic year.

In order to become a guide for MSU, you must be able to commit a significant amount of time to the program. This includes attending all attached events and learning information about MSU's campus, history, and traditions. After completing this training, guides will also need to commit to giving three tours per month and attending biweekly meetings.

Once again, thank you for your interest in joining MSU Campus Tours. We look forward to meeting you and hopefully working with you as a Campus Tour Guide.
